When it comes to capital investments, Gujarat has come out as the top choice for investors. Gujarat has achieved the top rank in the 'Ease of doing business' survey conducted by the International Finance Corporation (IFC), according to the Business Reputation Action Plan (BRAP) 2020 report.

The Gujarat State Investment Promotion and 301 Promotions and is supported by the Department for Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIT), Gujarat, and the Central Economic Board (CEB) Memorandum (REM) data released by DPIT.

Gujarat is becoming a leading position in the country by having the highest number of FDI inflows across states.

Gujarat offers the longest coastline of 1,600 kms, spread over 48 ports, which is a boon for export-driven industries. Gujarat has a total installed capacity of approximately 40,000 MW which is supplied 24x7 to industries.

About 40% of the state's total pop-



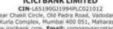
energy resources come from renewable sources. This only goes on to prove the state's commitment towards green industry. The combination of all these factors, and visible support of effectively modern Gujarat an attractive destination for investors.

Gujarat is the first and only Indian state to be to be completely covered under the piped gas distribution network, 98% more than 80% of the country's natural gas imports coming through its ports. Gujarat, since March 2002 set up the Petroleum Planning and Analysis Cell, Ministry of Petroleum and Natural Gas, now BPS ONGC stations, the highest number of stations in the country.

Gujarat is considered a model state for creating gas-based ecosystem and it is best positioned to leverage this for adopting green fuel for transport system.
